For reporting purposes, College of Medical Arts considers this to mean graduates who are working as Certified Nurse Assistants in skilled nursing facilities, for nursing home staffing registries, for home health care agencies, in acute care hospitals or in other health care capacities, or who are working as care providers in an either assisted living/residential care for the elderly, or an intermediate care for the developmentally disabled facility.
